

IBL Kick-off & Support

We have officially kicked off the Inquiry Based Learning (IBL) project. Students are choosing a Cambridge Global Perspective topic and developing a question where through research and critical thinking, they develop a proposed solution for the topic they choose. Students begin this process with Ms. Long in the library by selecting a topic, by learning database research skills, and by learning how to generate a works cited page. Students continue this process in their Literacy classes by learning how to turn their topic into an argumentative essay. While students will have some opportunities to work on this during school, they are expected to use time away from school to complete some of the assignments and tasks.

For those who need computer and Internet access, or additional help with the IBL project, Ms. Long will be opening the library on Tuesday mornings at 7:30 am and Wednesday afternoons until 5:15 pm. Students must sign up to attend these sessions. Students attending in the morning may enter through the cafeteria door. Students attending in the afternoon must be picked up by 5:15 pm. 
- Wrestling- Our next home Wrestling match will be Weds. Jan 29th against Bellevue. Tickets are \$2

Online Academic Help & Practice

If your child needs academic help or more practice, there are three resources that our school recommends. Our school has student subscriptions for IXL and Study Island. The IXL subscription covers Math and Science while the Study Island subscription covers all subjects. Khan Academy is another free online resource that covers all subjects. To help students meet their projected MAP RIT goals, we encourage students to login to Study Island and click on their NWEA individual pathway. This is aligned to their individual 2nd MAP score in Math and Reading. Our goal is for all students to show growth, and at least 60% or more of our students meet their projected RIT score next month. On days your child does not have homework, please encourage them to login and spend 30 minutes on this.




