Online Academic Help & Practice

If your child needs academic help or more practice, there are three resources that our school recommends. Our school has student subscriptions for IXL and Study Island. The IXL subscription covers Math and Science while the Study Island subscription covers all subjects. Khan Academy is another free online resource that covers all subjects. To help students meet their projected MAP RIT goals, we encourage students to login to Study Island and click on their NWEA individual pathway. This is aligned to their individual 2nd MAP score in Math and Reading. On days your child does not have homework, please encourage them to login and spend 30 minutes on this.

As the 4th quarter approaches, time on Study Island and IXL can help your child close achievement gaps, advance their learning, and prepare for TN Ready testing.
