- IBL Argumentative Essays- Students should be getting close to finishing their 1st draft of their IBL argumentative essay. The final drafts are due before Spring Break. If your child needs assistance, please have them reach out to their Literacy teacher and/or have them sign up for IBL tutoring in the library.

Online Academic Help & Practice

If your child needs academic help or more practice, there are three resources that our school recommends. Our school has student subscriptions for IXL and Study Island. The IXL subscription covers Math (6th & 7th grade) while the Study Island subscription covers all subjects. Khan Academy is another free online resource that covers all subjects. To help students meet their projected MAP RIT goals and improve their scores on TN Ready, we encourage students to login to Study Island and click on their NWEA individual pathway. This is aligned to their individual 2nd MAP score in Math and Reading. Our goal is for all students to show growth, and at least 60% or more of our students meet their projected RIT score. On days your child does not have homework, please encourage them to login and spend 30 minutes on this.
