Getting Started: Important Forms

Getting started virtually requires us to make many adjustments in how we teach and how students learn. It also requires some changes in how we distribute and receive information. Since we cannot send information home with students, we will need your help with sending or submitting some information digitally.

This past week, homeroom teachers shared with students how parents can submit the yearly migrant survey. The information helps us get resources to families in need. This is required for 5th grade students, but 6th-8th grade parents can opt out. Please see the link

(https://itsallthurgood.weebly.com/forms.html) to download the migrant survey or to complete the opt out form. This form should be emailed to your child's homeroom teacher or Ms. Reyes in the main office (anahi.reyes@mnps.org). We would like these forms to be emailed by the end of the week.

In addition, the MNPS Student-Parent Handbook is online this year (https://www.mnps.org/handbook). Parents will use their email attached to their student's Infinite Campus account to submit their permissions online. Parents can choose their preferred language, download the forms, and mail them to the school (if they don't have an email). If parents do not have an email on file or need to re-set their email, they should contact Ms. Reyes who can update or make changes in Infinite Campus. September 4th is the targeted deadline for parents to submit, mail, or email the permission forms to the school.

7th Grade Vaccinations


An updated Tennessee Immunization Certificate with proof of one additional immunizations is required when entering 7th grade. Immunizations are available from your child's doctor, or may also be available through the Metro Public Health Department if your child has TennCare, no insurance or insurance that does not pay for vaccines. *Please fax (#615-941-7521), mail, or email a copy of your child's immunization record to* **amanda.sowell@mnps.org.** If you email the records, please do not send a cell phone picture, but use a scan to pdf app to convert your picture to a printable PDF file.
