## **Honoring Coach Moragne**

We wanted to formerly acknowledge the passing of Mr. Moragne, or Coach Brian as he was referred to by those who knew him. He was part of the founding group of educators that opened Marshall in 2008. He was part of the Marshall staff up until 2018. Our current students may not know him directly, but he helped establish the Thurgood Marshall way. As a Math teacher, he taught generations of 5th and 6th grade students. He would mentor young men and women to be the best version of themselves. Students who worked with him knew they were going to be challenged, encouraged, and most of all loved.

As a basketball coach, he established a strong winning tradition with our girl's and boys' basketball teams. His teams routinely finished among the top in the city, including countless undefeated seasons, numerous western division championships, and a city championship as recently as 2015. Coach B was a man of devoted faith, and he walked with a quiet humbleness. He often took time to reflect and be thankful for the blessings and special moments in his life. He would give of himself to others to ensure their comfort over his own, and understood the power of patience and understanding. He knew everyone was different, but those differences didn't mean they deserved anything less than love and kindness.

Coach Morange reflected everything Thurgood Marshall Middle was built upon. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family and loved ones during this time.

## 7th Grade Vaccinations


An updated Tennessee Immunization Certificate with proof of one additional immunizations is required when entering 7th grade. Immunizations are available from your child's doctor, or may also be available through the Metro Public Health Department if your child has TennCare, no insurance or insurance that does not pay for vaccines. *Please fax (#615-941-7521), mail, or email a copy of your child's immunization record to* **amanda.sowell@mnps.org.** If you email the records, please do not send a cell phone picture, but use a scan to pdf app to convert your picture to a printable PDF file.
