Spotlight on STEM

According to Forbes.com, "Preparing students for future careers in STEM as well as for a workplace that emphasizes independence and flexibility is the major task ahead of anyone interested in education today." Ms. Regnier's STEM Career Arts classes at Marshall strive to focus on STEM careers through hands-on learning.

The 5th grade focuses on space exploration careers through designing and launching rockets, building and testing rovers, and experimenting on electronic circuits. The 6th grade focuses on green energy careers by designing and testing water wheels and wind turbines and on robotic careers through building and programming robots. The 7th grade also focuses on green energy careers by designing and creating energy efficient houses, and on microbiology careers by learning how to use lab equipment, lab specimen, as well as robotic careers by building and program robots. The 8th grade focuses on using forensic science to solve crimes, and on using tools to construct metal robots for programming.

This is a great time to check in with your child and discuss their progress so far, as well as their goals for this year.

We Are Growing


