

Thurgood Marshall Lunch Distribution

We want to continue to be a beacon in our community during these uncertain times. Our nutrition staff will be providing breakfast and lunch during this virtual start of the 2020-2021 school year. Please note the following:

Thurgood Marshall Middle **will require a free- and reduced-price application** for families who are eligible for free/reduced pricing. *This means that lunch is no longer free and cost \$3 and the reduced price is \$.40*

Families can use last year's eligibility status through Sept. 14, 2020 or until a new application is processed. Thurgood is no longer eligible for the Community Eligibility Provision and therefore cannot offer lunch at no-cost to all students. [Apply here.](#)

Meals at Schools: Beginning Tuesday, August 4, each school will offer grab and go breakfast and lunch service between 11:30 a.m. – 1:00pm

Walkers / Bike Riders can come between 11:30am – 12:00pm

On a piece of paper please have the following information available for staff to collect so we can distribute the lunches fast and efficient:

To Receive a Meal, students or parents must provide:

- *student name*
- *school where student is enrolled*
- *grade level*
- *birth date*
- *and 190 student identification number*

Please remain in your cars as we follow the guidelines from MNPS and the CDC.

A staff member from the nutrition staff and/or the school will come and assist you if you have any issue or concerns.

Parents/Guardians who are picking up lunches enter the school here.



*Continue around until you reach here and follow the directions of the Nutrition/
School Staff*





Meals will be delivered through bus routes and stops that would normally transport students to and from school.

Delivery times are generally:

- **12:45 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. for middle school students.**

Meals at Bus Route Stops: Bus route information is available using the [Find My Stop app at mnps.org/transportation](https://mnps.org/transportation) and students should try to arrive at least 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time
